## 'Snowpoles" – Never use painted wood again!


Snow removal and guidance on today's highways present some unique problems, especially at night and at the critical hours of dusk and dawn, during inclement weather and fog when visibility is reduced. There is a critical need for highly visible guides that help plow operators to avoid hazards and damage to fixed objects.

Research has shown that fluorescent colors grab the eye's attention quickly. Not only in daytime but also in limited light during sunset and dawn, or on dark, gray winter days when visibility is limited, SnowPoles stand out boldly helping to guide snow plow operators, drivers, utility workers, skiers, snowmobile drivers, and more!

The result is tremendous visibility and the promise of fewer accidents and lower costs associated with damage to fixed objects, such as guardrails, curbs, trees etc.

With a honeycomb cross-section that provides great strength and light weight, the engineered plastic compositions are modified for cold temperature impact resistance. Like a tree in the wind, SnowPoles poles bend under a load and return to a full upright position.

Through a combination of quality materials & design, we assure a superior performance in tough conditions. SnowPoles can weather stormy conditions! These SnowPoles have proven their value time and time again. You won't get this kind of performance with branches cut from local forests. You won't get it from imported bamboo or 1x2's from the hardware store. SnowPoles provide advance warning to plow operators of locations of objects such as guardrails road edges, and easy clearing of storm drains. The round 1.3" poles are a highly visible target from any angle of approach, showing operators where to plow safely for example. Reflective sheeting can be affixed to poles for even safer guidance after dark.

- Mark culverts and drains + Mark guardrail ends + Locate junction boxes
- Mark fire hydrants + Set snowmobile courses + Mark cross-country ski trails

- Delineate lift lines
- Marking School & Pedestrian crosswalks The Fluorescent Yellow/Green SnowPole is perfect for this!
- Mark curb stops, corners etc.
- Mark drainage grates for leaf or snow removal
- Mark designated areas for snow piling and many more uses!
- UV-stabilized colors include Maintenance Orange, Yellow Dark Green, Blue Black or vibrant Florescent Orange and Fluorescent Yellow/Green
